COURSE OUTLINE

When you study for a diploma you learn by 'doing'. So expect a mixture of conventional classroom theory and 'real world' practical projects and be prepared to work as a team, just as you would in the workplace. The course provides opportunities for visits to local businesses and quest speakers to work with you in the classroom.

KEY INFORMATION

Prior attainment:

Four grades at 9-4 L2 Pass grade in business is preferred.

Assessment:

40% internal assessment 60% external assessment 2 units (assessed by exam board) Written exam Written task 2 units (assessed internally and moderated)
