Year 10 and 11 visit to Bath Forum for GCSE Science Live!

On Tuesday 4 February St Katherine's School will be visiting Bath Forum to attend the 'GCSE Science Live!' event. GCSE Science Live! is a science event designed specifically for GCSE students. Students will have five inspirational talks from some of Britain's top scientists; Professor Robert Winston who works in fertility, Professor Dave Cliff who works in computer science, Professor Alice Roberts who is a clinical anatomist and presents science programmes on BBC2, Dr Simon Singh who is a journalist in the field of maths and science and Dr Helen Czerski who is an Oceanographer. This is a fantastic opportunity for students to hear about the current work of these leading scientists and be inspired to consider scientific careers. During the day students will also receive an examination tips session from a senior GCSE examiner. Each student will receive a booklet with the details of each scientist and their lectures, some articles about studying science and careers in science, as well as some further examination technique advice.

Places on the trip are limited as we have been allocated just 45 places. If oversubscribed, places will be allocated by lottery. The trip will cost £25.00 which covers all travel costs and entrance fees. The closing date for the receipt of payment is **Friday 6 December**. Payments will be refunded for anyone who is unsuccessful in securing a place.

In cases of financial hardship, the school may be able to offer assistance towards the cost of this trip/activity. Please write to the Headteacher in confidence detailing your circumstances and the amount you are able to contribute.

Please find attached an Essential Information Form for the 2019/2020 academic year. This must be completed and returned to the student support office or emailed to school@skdrive.org. We are unable to take students out of school unless we have this information to hand.

We will be travelling by coach, leaving the school during period 1 and returning at approximately 4:00pm. Students will wear full school uniform and will need a packed lunch.
